



TEAM BUILDING OPTIONS: GO KARTING:

Endurance TEAM race, N\$480 incl. VAT per person

Minimum 10 drivers. Maximum 40 drivers.

- This is the perfect option for strategic thinking and quick decision making.
- The event starts with an introduction and safety briefing, followed by a compulsory practise session of 6 laps per person.
- Based on this practise we will make the teams (slower and faster drivers together in teams).
- Each team will get 1 kart; team members must make a strategy and change drivers in the pit lane during the course of the race.
- There will be a compulsory number of driver changes.
- The winner of the race is the team who completes the given laps first; they will be celebrated on our podium with champagne and medals!
- Duration of event can be anything from 1 hour to 3 hours depending on group size.

STANDARD Shoot out-Competition, N\$330 incl. VAT per person

Minimum 15 drivers. Maximum 200 drivers.

- All drivers will drive 14 laps on the track in groups of 8.
- When everyone is finished we select the 8 fastest drivers for the final 14 laps race.
- The winner of the final will get champagne or a medal on our podium.
- Duration of the event can be anything from 45 minutes to 8 hours depending on group size.

MINI Shoot out-Competition, N\$250 incl. VAT per person

Minimum 15 drivers. Maximum 200 drivers.

- All drivers will drive 7 laps on the track in groups of 8.
- When everyone is finished we select the 8 fastest drivers for the final 7 laps race.
- For booking more than 60 drivers we will include a semi final race as well.
- The winner of the final will get champagne or a medal on our podium.
- Duration of event can be anything from 45 minutes to 8 hours depending on group size

STANDARD Go karting Rates:

- **5 Minutes, Max 5 laps - N\$120 incl. VAT per person**
- **10 Minutes, Max 10 laps - N\$220 incl. VAT per person**
- **Mini GP (5 laps practice followed by a grid start from fastest to slowest with a 10 laps race) - N\$300 pp incl. VAT**
- **Super GP (8 laps practice, followed by a grid start from fastest to slowest followed by a 14 laps race, podium celebration for the winners) - N\$480 pp incl. VAT**
- **Birthday special: 5 laps practice, 5 laps race with podium celebration - N\$250 pp**

TEAM BUILD CHALLENGES:

To better internal communication, team spirit, team work and problem solving we have the following team building options below that will help work on the problem areas within your team.

BLIND FOLD GAME: N\$100 incl. VAT per person

(Great for internal communication and building trust!)

We will divide your group into teams.

- One member will be blindfolded and the other team member will have to instruct their team mate through our maze course safely.
- Teams will be timed and points scored based on who can guide their partner through the maze in the quickest time.

MINUTE TO WIN IT: N\$150 incl. VAT per person

(Test your staff's ability to work and think under pressure and to have fun at the same time)

- As individuals you will be competing in a series of little 'Minute to Win-It' challenges. (Such as the cookie munch, the cereal box puzzle etc).
- A series of 5 different challenges will be set up and each member of your team will compete in one or more of these games.
- The team with the highest overall score will be announced the winner

TREASURE HUNT: N\$100 incl. VAT per person

(Great problem solving activity!)

We will divide your group into teams.

- Each group will receive a map of the area and clues.
- Each team will then go on a treasure hunt where they have to find 10 items which will spell a word.
- The team that can first assemble station will be the winning team.
- We will incorporate something from your company in this event, to test your team on your company product.

CONSTRUCTIVE CRITTERS - Collaborative Building Challenge: N\$150 incl. VAT per person

To promote creative thinking, collaboration, and resource management while working under constraints

- Each team draws a critter card to determine what they will be building.
- Teams are given a set time (e.g 15 min) to build a representation of their critter using only the provided materials.
- The twist: every 3 minutes, a facilitator announces a constraint or challenge to which the team needs to adapt.
- At the end of the building period, teams present their critters, explaining their design choices and how they adapted to the introduced constraints.

YES NO CHALLENGE – "Decisive Leap": N\$50 incl. VAT per person

Objective To sharpen reaction times and hone decision-making skills in a fun, competitive setting.

We will divide your group into teams.

- The facilitator randomly shouts either "Yes" or "No".
- Participants must quickly jump to the side corresponding to the shouted word.
- If the facilitator shouts an incorrect word or any other word, participants must remain still.
- Participants who jump to the wrong side or move when they shouldn't are disqualified.
- Rounds continue until one participant remains, the last man standing

CATCH THE CUP CHALLENGE – "Cascade Cup Catch": N\$50 incl. VAT per person

Objective

To foster teamwork, enhance communication, and develop coordination skills among participants.

We will divide your group into teams.

- One team member stands with 1 cup in their hand, while the other team member has 10 cups.
- The team member with the 10 cups should throw it into the air towards his team member who has one cup.
- The team member with the one cup must try and catch the cups, with the cup they have.
- The team who catches all the cups first wins.

DANCE CHALLENGE – "Rhythmic Relay Remix: N\$50 incl. VAT per person

Objective

To boost team spirit, promote creativity, and encourage active participation in a fun and lively setting.

We will divide your group into teams.

- Our facilitator will demonstrate a certain dance move (with the appropriate music) which the team should first observe.
- After this demonstration, the team gets 5 minutes to practice the dance move shown.
- After the 5 minutes they will be granted one opportunity to demonstrate the dance they practiced.
- The judge will determine which group is closest to the one demonstrated by the facilitator.
- The group that gets the moves most accurately wins.

Emoji Emote-off" – Expressive Communication Challenge: N\$50 incl. VAT per person

Objective

To foster non-verbal communication skills, promote empathy, and develop a deeper understanding of team members' expressive capabilities.

We will divide your group into teams.

- The "emoter" from each team picks a card without showing it to anyone and observes the emoji on it.
- On the signal, the "emoter" must convey the emotion of the emoji using only facial expressions and body language, without making any sounds.
- Their team has 30 seconds to guess the correct emotion based on the "emoter's" expressions.
- After each round, a new member becomes the "emoter," and the game continues.

Scoring:

- A point is awarded for each correctly guessed emoji.
- Bonus points for particularly challenging or nuanced emotions.
- Tally up scores after a set number of rounds to determine the winner.

Bar
